

# **DRUGS**

Drugs are chemical substances with a capacity to affect the Central Nervous System by producing a state of intoxication or a similar change in mental functions.

# **Drugs encompass a Large Number of Preparations**

- 1. Narcotic Drugs
- 2. Psychotropic Substances
- 3. Medicinal Drugs
- 4. General Anaesthetics

- 5. Volatile solvents
- 6. Doping agents
- 7. Alcohol & tobacco





# Narcotic Drugs

Narcotic drugs are internationally defined as chemical substances under control of the United Nations Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs (1961)



## This would include -

- Cannabis & Cannabis resin
- Opium
- Morphine (MORPHINE, CODEINE, PETHIDINE)
- Natural and synthetic opiates
- Coca leaves & Cocaine

#### **Psychotropic Substances**

Psychotropic Substances are internationally defined as substances under control of the UN Convention on Psychotropic Substances (1971).

# This would include

- >Amphetamine : Stimulants
- Depressants : Barbiturates,
- > Benzodiazepines, Mandrax
- > Barbiturates : Hallucinogens
- Benzodiazepines : Ecstasy












# PHARMACOLOGICA L CLASSIFICATION OF DRUGS OF ABUSE

- ► Narcotics pain killing, benumbing, produce a sense of well being
- Stimulants speed up working of the CNS
- Depressants slow down working of CNS
- Hallucinogens may put the brain machinery completely out of gear



#### **OPIUM**

Opium production is concentrated in notified areas in the states of Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan under stringent licensing regime monitored by Narcotics Commissioner of India, Gwalior.



# **OPIUM And itS Derivatives**

- opium or "afeem" or "afoo"-the king of narcotics
- coagulated juice of the poppy plant

- derivatives morphine, heroin,codeine and thebaine
- > single poppy plant bears about
  - 5-8 poppy capsules

- incising (lancing) the unripe poppy pods
- the latex, a milky white sap, oozes out and is scraped off with a knife

- ➤ Illicit poppy cultivated in the

  Golden Crescent and the Golden

  Triangle
- ► licit poppy is cultivated Turkey,

  Greece Australia and India

- In India, licit poppy in M.P., UP and Rajasthan
- >63,000 licensed farmers
- Supervised by CBN

# CODEINE

> alkaloid of opium poppy is a CNS

depressant

> synthesized from morphine

used commonly as cough suppressant,

analgesic, anti-diarrhoeal drug

> smuggled into north-east India and

Bangladesh where it is abused

# CODEINE

used in combination

with a paracetamol to

enhance effect



# HEROIN - CURSE OF THE 20TH CENTURY





- > a powerful addictive depressant
- It is more addictive than morphine
- pure heroin is a white powder bitter in taste

- ▶ illicit heroin color varies from white to dark brown to black
- horse, joy powder, white lady, brown sugar, junk, pudia, saman, gard, smack.

abuse pattern – injected by skin popping or main-lining, inhaled (chasing the dragon), sniffed/snorted, smoked

#### WHAT HEROIN DOES

- causes drowsiness, inability to concentrate, apathy and loss of sex drive
- malnutrition and extreme weight loss

▶ risk of overdose is high resulting in death due to respiratory suppression

> sharing of contaminated injecting

needle and likelihood HIV/AIDS

unavailability of the drug causes
withdrawl symptoms

addict may resort to serious crimes
or compromise to obtain required

dose

prescribed as sedatives and





> Useful in treating anxiety,

insomnia, agitation, seizures and

muscle spasms

- Among the most frequently prescribed medicines world wide
- Have addictive potential and dependence may develop very fast
- Action of duration alprazolam or lorazepam for ST, rohypnol for MT and diazepam (valium) for LT effects

- recreational drug of choice of America
- use permeates into the powerful and socially prominent circles

white crystalline alkaloid

found in leaves of Coca bush

grown in South America especially

Peru, Bolivia and Columbia

- Coca known as Bolivian
- Coca paste made from coca leaves
- street names coke, snow, crack, rocks, charlie


- very addictive drug
- cocaine is a white powder
- it is snorted, smoked or injected

#### **SNORTING COCAINE LINES**

cocaine addiction can lead to heart

attack, respiratory failure, seizures,

anxiety, nervousness and paranoia

chronic addicts experience "cocaine

leaps"

- mixing cocaine/crack with any other drug is extremely dangerous
- Price upto Rs 2 crore per kg in India and upto Rs 4 crore in USA and Europe

- ➤ Celebrity addicts Sigmond
  Freud, Arthur Conan Doyle
- ► R.L. Stevenson (1885) wrote Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde in only 6 days and nights on cocaine binge

# **CANNABIS**

- The most widely abused drug world wide
- ► It grows in more than 172 countries, in most places as a wild shrub


## **CANNABIS**

- Active ingredient is tetra hydrocannabinol (THC)
- In India too it is the most widely abused drug with about 8.7 million addicts

### **CNNABIS**

Mostly cannabis is cultivated in J&K, H.P., Andhra Pradesh, Orissa





# MARIJUANA OR GANJA

- ➤ Flowering tops of female plant contain THC 5%
- Smoked as chilam by sadhus, fakirs, Sufis, labourers

- ➢ In cigarettes as "Reefers" or "Joints"
- Also known as Pot in Mexico grown frequently in flower pots
- ➤ Street names: Bonbo, Buddha sticks, Ganja, Kif, Hemp, Joint stocks, Pot, Thai Sticks, Grass

## HASHISH / CHARAS


- **▶** It is the concentrated resin
- ▶10 to 15% THC
- Kashmir (laddu)
- > HP Malana cream

## HASHISH / CHARAS

- Nepal (slabs)
- Morocco supplies 70 % of Europe hashish, known as Kif
- > also H, hash, pot, shit
- green house cultivation

# **EFFECTS**





## **EFFECTS**

- Impairs STM, concentration, performance in general esp in studies
- > Affects heart functions
- Long time use associated with mental illness

# **EFFECTS**

- > Impairs respiratory functions
- Cannabis joint contains more cancer causing agents than the strongest tobacco cigarettes
- Cannabis traces in body can be detected upto 30 days after initial use

## LSD - PASSPORT TO HEAVEN (OR HELL)

- ► LSD Lysergic acid diethylamide
- The most potent hallucinogen known to mankind
- Discovered in 1943 by Dr. Hoffman of Sandoz

- Dr. Hoffman himself took the drug and later felt slight dizziness, unrest, loss of concentration, visual disturbance and marked desire to laugh. After this he was unable to write down his symptoms
- He later recalled, "My field of vision swayed before me and was distorted like the reflections in an amusement park mirror. I had the impression of being unable to move from the spot, although my assistant later told me we cycled at a good pace."

- Colourless, tasteless, odourless liquid
- Had on a piece of blotting paper and in stamps and stickers, hidden behind them
- > Street names are hippie and acid
- Most powerful drug known to man
- **▶1** gram is enough for 1 lakh users
- Leads to feeling of persecution, violent behavior
- LSD as shortcut to meditation and mystical revelation
- Good and bad trips (bum trips)






# PEYOTE CACTUS







## PEYOTE CACTUS

- Peyote Cactus is also called the divine cactus or mescal buttons
- Small spineless cactus which grows in the Chihuahuan desert of Mexico

#### PEYOTE CACTUS

- Mescaline is a hallucinogenic substance found in the cactus in the form of small buttons attached to the stem
- ▶ Bizarre hallucination to gain access to the spiritual world

#### **PSILOCYBIN MUSHROOMS**

- > Hallucinogenic mushroom found in southern Mexico
- ➤ Effects are extremely close to those of LSD
- Street names are magic mushrooms, divine flesh

# ECSTASY (MDMA) OR AGONY

- Consumption is in tablet or capsule form
- Street names are disco burgers,
  Dennis the Menace, lovers speed,
  adam, XTC


- Its effect is euphoric 'rush' with heightened perception of surroundings
- Feeling of emotional closeness to others (empathy)
- Facilitation of communication and increased sociability
- Used at Rave parties and clubs
- **▶** Price ranges from Rs.1000-2500 per tablet

# AMPHETAMINES- ATS / SPEED

- Synthesized in 1887 to as a cheap substitute to asthma drugs and treat sleep disorder
- ► After 40 years it was declared to be a powerful stimulant of CNS


- Widely used by soldiers in World War II to keep going
- In 1950's Japan and USA witnessed large scale abuse
- ► It gained popularity in 1950s amongst students and truck drivers
- ► Users are "speed freaks" seeking a thrill from the drug

- Initial flash or rush is exhilarating and the prime motive for abuse
- ► Tolerance develops very fast




- Speed Binge
- Street names are Browns, Hearts, Oranges, Rippers, Wake ups
- They all give effects like hyperactivity, extended wakefulness and loss of

appetite

## CLUB DRUGS

- Used at all night dance parties such as raves or trance parties, dance clubs and bars
- To create a feeling of altered mood and a high known as a "trip" and to give energy to keep dancing or to

cause sedation

## CLUB DRUGS

- Some can be used to assist in the commission of sexual assault and are referred to as date rape drugs
- Easily added to flavoured drink or alcohol without victim's knowledge as they are colourless, odourless and tasteless

- Ketamine also known as K, special k, vitamin k, cat valium
- Rohypnol also known as roofies,roche, forget-me pill
- Methamphetamine also known as speed, ice, chalk, meth, crystal, crank, fire, glass

- LSD also known as acid, boomers, yellow sunshines
- Most victims experience anterograde amnesia
- Effects appear within 15 to 20 minutes and may last upto 10-12 hours
- All traces of the drug leave the body within 72 hours and are not found in routine toxicology screen or blood test

#### PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS

- Indian pharmaceutical industry is ranked third in volume terms globally
- There are over six lakh chemists
- Some legitimate pharmaceutical preparations can also be addictive if used without prescription and indiscriminately

#### PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS


- Cough syrups containing codeine such as phensedyl and corex
- Tranquilizers such as alprazolam, rohypnol, diazepam (valium)

- Barbiturates such as secobarbital, pentobarbital and amobarbital
- Pain killers such as Proxyvon,

  Spasmoproxyvon, Beuprenorphine,

  Fentanyls
- ► Injections such as Tidigesic, Norphine, Avil.





#### PRECURSOR CHEMICALS

- The term precursor is used for chemicals having legitimate uses in industry which can be misused for manufacturing illicit drugs
- India's highly developed chemical industry is a source of Precursor Chemicals

#### PRECURSOR CHEMICALS

The UN has identified 23 precursor chemicals

India has placed controls over 12 such chemicals to prevent diversion

# DRUG ABUSE SCENARIO IN INDIA

- National Survey on Drug Abuse in India 2012
- Major Drugs of abuse –
- Alcohol 135.5million users
- Cannabis 10 million users
- **Opiates 3.5 million users**

# WHY DO YOUNG PEOPLE TAKE DRUGS

- ➤ Under peer pressure to be accepted, be popular, fit in and to impress friend
- ► Stress management to run away from problems and loneliness

- Enjoyment, excitement and fun, to feel good and to get energy
- ➤ Risk taking and rebellion being urged or challenged by friend
- Out of curiosity to experiment

## ADDICTION

- The need for repeated doses of a drug to feel good or to avoid feeling bad is a sign of addiction
- All mind altering drugs are ADDICTIVE in nature

## **ADDICTION**

After few doses, the body starts

<u>DEMANDING</u> them

► Repeated usage of a drug results in reduced effects, or TOLERANCE

## ADDICTION

- Unpleasant physical symptoms that result from stopping the drug or its unavailability are known as WITHDRAWAL SYMPTOMS
- Can resort to stealing or even graver crimes

>Global production of illicit poppy has shot up to a record 9000 MT
Afghanistan alone accounts for 90 % of world's poppy and heroin production
Sharp decline in production in the Golden Triangle
Columbia (54%), Peru (30%) and Bolivia (15%) account for almost entire cocaine
production


#### **GLOBAL DRUG ECONOMY**

- Present global illicit drug market is worth around US\$ 500 Bn
- **▶** Profits alone run into US\$ 75 Bn
- Higher than GDP of 88 % of nations in the world
- Cannabis grown globally
- Drug trafficking and narcoterrorism

### NARCO TERRORISM

- ▶ Term coined by former President of Peru Fernando Terry in 1983
- ➤ Refers to terrorist acts carried out by groups that are directly or indirectly involved in drug trade
