4. This permit is not-transferable.
5. This permit-holder shall comply with all lawful orders issued to him by the Government, the Commissioner, the Collector or the ² [Superintendent or District Inspec-tor of prohibition and Excise of his district.]
6. The permit-holder shall abide by the conditions of this permit and the provisions of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949, and the rules, regulations and orders made thereunder and shall give an undertaking to that effect.
7. The permit may be suspended or cancelled in accordance with the provisions of section 54 of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949.
8. In case the permit is suspeneded or cancelled the entire stock of foreign liquor in the possession of the permit-holder on the date of such suspension or cancellation shallforthwith be surrendered by him to the Collector.
